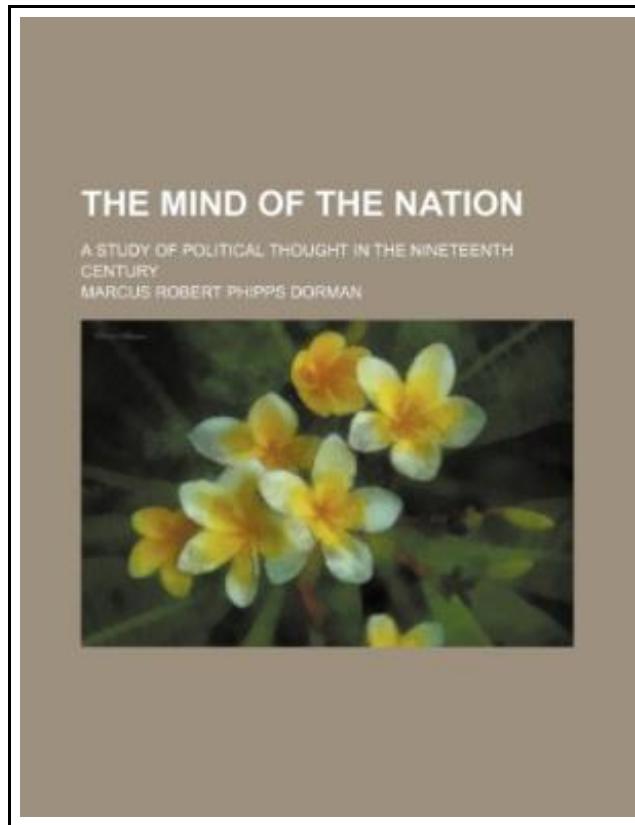

CHAPTER V THE PRINCIPLES OF THE PARTIES Section I. --Constitutional Development Most men in the upper and middle classes, and many artisans, style themselves Liberals or Conservatives, but if one enquires why they do so, the reason given in nearly all cases is not connected with the general principles and history of the two parties, but is limited to the policy adopted, and the measures proposed or passed within the last twenty years. In general terms the Liberals advocate peace, retrenchment, and reform, and no one, without the strongest reasons, desires war, extravagance, or laissez aire, therefore we must all be Liberals. The Conservatives, on the other hand, advocate the preservation of the Empire, the maintenance of our institutions, and the improvement of the condition of the people, and it is difficult to find fault with such principles; therefore we must all be Conservatives. The catchwords Liberty, Equality, and Fraternity were first raised during the French Revolution, and the United States shout Liberty on all occasions, while the great Conservative society, the Primrose League, uses for its motto, Imperium et Libertas. But modern statesmen seldom use catchwords, which obviously mean nothing, or refer to general party principles, but confine themselves to the measures which interest the country at the moment, although they sometimes venture on definitions of such terms as Jingo, Imperialist, Little Englander, and Mr Gladstone once defined a Radical as a Liberal in earnest, leaving us in happy doubt as to the meaning...
