The purpose of the CONCUR conference is to bring together researchers, developers and students in order to advance the theory of concurrency and promote its applications. Interest in this topic is continually growing, as a consequence of the importance and ubiquity of concurrent systems and their applications, and of the scientific relevance of their foundations. The scope covers all areas of semantics, logics, and verification techniques for concurrent systems. Topics include concurrency-related aspects of: models of computation, semantic domains, process algebras, Petri nets, event structures, real-time systems, hybrid systems, schedulability, model-checking, verification techniques, renaming techniques, term and graph rewriting, distributed programming, logic constraint programming, object-oriented programming, typing systems and algorithms, case studies, tools and environments for programming and verification. This volume starts with four invited papers: from Sriram Rajamani, Steve Brookes, Bengt Jonsson and Peter O'Hearn. The remaining 29 papers were selected by the program committee from 141 submissions, a record number of submissions to CONCUR. The standard was extremely high and the selection difficult. Each submission received at least three reports, reviewed by the program committee members or their subreferees. Once...
