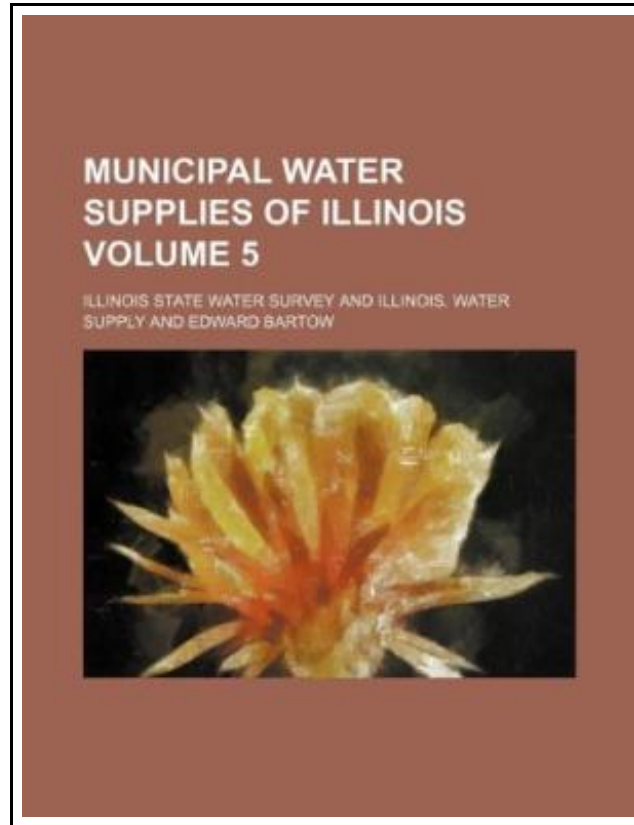

An analysis of the mineral content gave the following results: Galva, Henry county (2,682), obtains its water supply from deep wells 1,500 feet deep. The system is owned by the city and was established in 1894. Gardner, Grundy county (1,036), has no general city supply. Geneseo, Henry county (3,356), is located about a mile from Green river. Source of municipal supply is springs and wells. The plant is owned by the city and was established in 1902 at a cost of \$20,000. The pumping station is located two miles north of the city. A Gould triplex pump, with capacity of 25,000 gallons per hour, is used. The water is not treated and the daily consumption is about 160,000 gallons. A new well was put in in 1906. For sanitary analysis of new well see final table. Mineral analysis of the spring water gave the following results: Geneva, Kane county (2,446), obtains its water supply from artesian wells 2,500 feet deep. The system is owned by the city. Genoa, DeKalb county (1,140), obtains its water supply from a well 1,500 feet deep. The system is owned by the village and was established at a cost of \$2,500. A Downie pump and air pressure tanks are used. The daily consumption is 50,000 gallons. For sanitary analysis see final table. Germantown, Vermilion county (1,782), obtains its water supply from the Danville City Water Company. It was annexed to...
